During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 30% (100); Paper entries 70% (230). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or the paper limits accordingly.

- All entries received before the Opening Date will be returned.
- The Club and their Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the Entry form by the owner or agent of the owner.
- Incomplete and/or illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Be sure to:
 - Write legibly
 - Complete each field
 - Make sure all classes you are entered in are either all Regular or all Preferred classes – do not mix
 - Include a copy of the AKC Agreement whether printed next to or on the back of the Entry form
 - Sign the Entry form
 - If required, include a copy of a completed and signed Boulder City, NV Release of Liability
- Envelopes or transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.
- Overnight, express or certified mail must be sent with the “No Signature Required” waiver signed.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- No entries will be accepted by hand delivery within the first 24 hours from the Opening Date, nor ever by phone, fax, or email.

AFTER THE CLOSING DATE Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 21 and Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

REVIEW YOUR ENTRY: You will be sent an Entry Received email close to the date your entry is received, and after close, an Entry Confirmation email. This is your only opportunity to notify the Trial Secretary of errors.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. The Club may add a \$35.00 collection fee (optional) to the amount of each returned check, and exhibitor will be put on a “cash only” basis.

DECLINE OF ENTRIES: The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove, any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club, or any official thereof.

WAIT LIST for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date and Time:

The Club is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date and time. A maximum of 15 entries (total mail-in and/or AKC-OLE) will be placed on the club's wait list.

All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the event's closing date and time as posted on the Premium List cover.

Any entries withdrawn that are received by the move-up date and time as posted on the Premium List cover will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry.

Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by move-up date and time as posted on the Premium List cover will receive a full refund.

****NEW** PREMIER STANDARD & JUMPERS CLASSES**

We are excited to announce the newest AKC Agility class – Premier.

This class will provide an opportunity for agility competitors to demonstrate different handling skills than those required for the Master Level Classes in Standard & Jumpers With Weaves. The Premier class will focus on handling the sequence or sequences of the day.

Both Standard and JWW Premier courses will be Master level courses incorporating a number of elements that challenge the dog and handler in ways that are not seen on traditional AKC courses. These elements include sequences like threadles, back-side jumps, pull-throughs, layering, challenging weave pole entries, and longer running passes. One bi-directional jump or tunnel will be allowed to encourage handling strategies. Obstacle spacing on Premier courses may exceed the limits of those on Master courses.

Premier courses will use the same obstacles as the corresponding Master course. There may be 3 tunnel passes and there will be no table. A Premier course will have 19 to 21 obstacles, 3 side switches, 4 Premier Elements and 5 Challenges. Courses will be judged using AKC Master scoring and hand signals.

ABOUT PREMIER as per AKC REGULATIONS

Chapter 11 - Premier Classes

Section 1. Purpose.

These optional titling classes are designed to challenge dogs and handlers at an increased speed and skill level above those set for the Master level classes. Handlers/dogs will need to negotiate courses that require varied approach angles, spacing, and obstacle discriminations to be successful in these classes. These classes are offered as separate titling tracks and are not part of the MACH/PACH Championships.

Section 2. Eligibility. Dogs with an AX title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Regular. Dogs with an AX or AXP title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Preferred. Dogs with an AXJ title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Regular. Dogs with an AXJ or AJP title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Preferred. Dogs with Regular titles may crossover to the Premier Preferred level as per AKC Regulations.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs should be physically sound. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Does Your Dog Need To Be Measured?

When filling out the entry form, there is a section for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

MOVE-UPS and DOWNS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title.

All pre-show move ups must be received according to the **Move-up Date** posted on the Premium List cover sheet. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. Please complete our convenient online form to submit your request::

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary has received them within 30 minutes after the end of the last class.

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to a Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Other than as stated above, there will be no other move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial'

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

REGULATIONS FOR AGILITY TRIALS

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the [Regulations for Agility Trials from the American Kennel Club website](http://www.akc.org/rules/) [http://www.akc.org/rules/].

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children and are in the care, custody and control of the exhibitor and/or owner at all times.. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash or otherwise confined at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course (See New AKC Leash Restrictions Start March 1, 2009). As per AKC Regulations, "Dogs shall be on leash at all times when on the show grounds except in the ring and at the warm-up jump area."**

It is strongly suggested that owners and/or exhibitors follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

By entering this show, exhibitors and agents agree to follow all directions of the special parking attendants charged with arranging and maintaining orderly conditions in all parking areas. Any arguing or abusive language may result in forfeiture of all parking privileges, without refund of fees (if applicable). Such actions may be subject to disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. All parking is at your own risk.

This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or

locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

It is the responsibility for the exhibitor to have their dog ready to be shown at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. It is not the responsibility of any officer or agent or employee of the Trial Committee to locate any dog when it is time for the dog to be in the judging ring. There is no rule of the AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring their dog into the ring.

COURTESY

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

SELF-CLEANING GROUNDS

A show committee will be called on anyone not cleaning up after their dog(s).

- A veterinary letter is provided to the Trial Secretary within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show.
